REGIONAL LITTLE LEAGUE BASEBALL REQUIRMENTS THIS APPLIES TO REGIONAL ASSOCIATIONS THAT ARE RECOGNISED AS A CHARTER IN THEIR OWN RIGHT



Prior to the commencement of each season, and no later than 1 October, regional associations seeking Charter status must submit to the Little League District Administrator (LLDA) (1) team numbers of the upcoming season (2) confirmation that players have been loaded into the MyClub system and (3) competition fixtures.

Once Charter status is granted, the Regional Association shall comply with the following standards:

- Reporting of game results and registration of players as per BWA regulations must be complied with.
- A copy of the association's constitution is to be sent to the BWA office for allocation of shareholder status if not previously done.
- Formation of a charter representative team to compete at the Little League State Championships and compliance with all relevant requirements.

It is expected that, in forming the charter representative team, the following guidelines are observed:

- Appointment of coaches, executive officers and managers is to be open and transparent at all times. Job descriptions should be prepared and all association members are to have the opportunity to apply for said positions.
- The process of selecting the team shall be determined by the coaching staff however must at all times be open and transparent. The process should be communicated to all eligible players prior to the selection process commencing.
- Team selection should be conducted by the team's coaching staff.
- Whilst discipline and commitment by the players needs to be observed, the concept of Little League is not to prevent players from participating in other normal activities and as such, the occasional absence from training or selection trials needs to be tolerated.
